Peggy Duquesnel:

A musician of stunning range and complexity, Peggy Duquesnel's achievements in music are a testament to her incredible devotion to her art.

Duquesnel has performed as featured pianist/vocalist with the Auckland Philharmonic Orchestra, toured as keyboardist with Dionne Warwick, performed as featured keyboard artist for the Roland Corporation U.S. and Kawai America Corporation, performed at numerous events for the Disney Corporation, and served as keyboardist for both the Anaheim Angels and the Mighty Ducks. She has recorded with numerous artists including Henry Mancini, Monica Mancini, Pocket Change, David Patt and Ric Flauding.

"Where is Love?" is a first-class production of jazz standards and originals featuring Peggy Duquesnel with her jazz trio. Recorded at Capitol Studios by Grammy Award-winning engineer Al Schmitt, it features six orchestra cuts arranged and conducted by the Grammy Award-winning Alan Broadbent. Peggy's original pieces "Hotel Blues and "Kiwi Friend" along with producer Mike Peak's original composition "Lucy" add a nice touch to this work of art.

"Show Me Your Way" features a vibrant collection of original songs of praise and worship plus some popular hymns. The music reveals Peggy's eclectic background in jazz, pop, Latin, gospel and the classics. Her unique blend of songwriting, piano improvisation and smooth vocals shine in both intimate and lively arrangements, featuring top-notch studio musicians and world-class background vocalists.
